## STOCKWELL ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP ASKS FOR YOUR SUPPORT

The Lynne Murray Stockwell Memorial Scholarship Fund was established at Ohio State in 2004 with gifts from family members, friends of Lynne Murray Stockwell, and the Middle

Tennessee Alumni Club. This fund provides merit-based scholarships to deserving freshmen students from Tennessee who are in the top 25% of their class. The

scholarships are awarded annually and are renewable for four years. Prospective recipients are interviewed, ranked and recommended by the Middle Tennessee Alumni Association Scholarship Committee, or by the Ohio State Alumni Association.

As of June 30, 2006, the balance is nearing \$73,000. Our current level of giving will fully fund the club's 2006 4-year scholarship of \$1,000 per year, as well as continue the 2004 & 2005 scholarships. To fund the fourth scholarship in Fall 2007, we ask your help to lift the fund balance above \$80K by year-end 2006.

We will be contacting you soon to see if you would be willing to add the club's Endowed Scholarship to your annual giving list. It is very important that we have a regular year-after-year component to the fund's revenue sources in addition to the revenue from one-time fund raising campaigns.
